Just as Moses' face shown with My glory, I have made you a light unto the world. Yes, My servant Moses did great exploits.

Elijah and Elisha did, too. My precious one, you're not exempt, for those who know Me will do great exploits. As you walk closer with Me, in My divine glory, you will be amazed at the work I will do in and through you. Nothing will be impossible for you. Come and enter My holy chamber. Come and know of Me so the world can see My glory in you – says the Spirit of the Lord.

GOD CHOSE MOSES to lead a nation to salvation. Like David, he was an incredible man who desired one thing: to know God's ways. Pondering the scripture, "*Many are called, but few are chosen*" (Matt 22:14), I uniquely interpret it like this: the *many* who are called to fulfill kingdom assignments can accept or reject the divine call. If they choose to decline, God will use someone else. But the few chosen— will do as commanded. That's right; those Jonahs cannot run or hide.

God foreordained divine assignments and callings for every living soul before the foundations of the world. He downloaded heavenly blueprints into our spirit upon conception, designed to be carried out during our lifetime. Ideally, as we mature and live out our lives, prophetic words are spoken to guide and

encourage the fulfillment of that destiny. The people we meet and the events we go through are to help us make choices, leading us to complete the divine assignment, *making all things work together to bring forth God's will and purpose on the earth* (Rom. 8:28). However, there's one catch – the *will* of humanity.

A prophetic *calling* is not a guarantee; it's an opportunity. Divine assignments are equivalent to a contract. It's a two-party conditional agreement where God offers His perfect plan based on your personality, character, and, yes, even your corky ways. When God reveals His assignment, demonstrated through your gifts, desires, talents, prophetic words, dreams, and visions, you can accept and partner with Him or reject the offer. Either way, His *gifts and callings are without repentance* (Rom. 11:29).

When you partner with God, you become impregnated with hope and promise. During the development, submission, rest, and preparation are practical keys to apply. The development time is critical because the enemy will get you to either abort the promise or birth it forth before the appointed time. As the saying goes, 'creating an Ishmael.'

My experiential advice is never to allow *your preconceived ideas to block the flow of the Holy Spirit's work*. Preconceived notions of how, when, and where the promise will occur are a set-up for getting on the wrong path. This is why you must be willing to yield to the preparation process. God knows what He is doing and wants to show you how He can overcome your thoughts of impossibilities.

There's always a preparation 'time' for your assignment, no matter your age. There's a time for building up faith and stripping off all *ungodly carnalities*. It's the process of crucifying your will and personal desires, learning to rely entirely on the Lord's leading. Then, at the appointed time, a birthing takes place. Moses' heart was truly humbled when he said, "Lord, who am I to lead these people?" He flipped and flopped, in his ways, like a fish out of water for eighty years until he finally understood that he couldn't even breathe without God's help.

Genuine humility is bowing the heart and accepting the Lord's ways, then listening to His gracious and encouraging words say, "I am with you! Here are your instructions: Follow Me, and let's make this happen."

David understood humility. Before he rode off to any battle, he entered his strong tower and put on his priestly garments to inquire of the Lord's direction. When David aligned himself with God, received instructions, and followed the Lord's lead, victory day came with the shout, *"That's how you do it, God!"* When we operate God's way, we can rejoice, saying, *"Great is our God!"*

There's a special place you can go to receive your instructions. It's the same place where God said to Moses, *"I will meet with you and talk to you from above the atonement cover between the gold cherubim that hover over the Ark of the Covenant"* (Ex. 25:22). This is the place where you will receive all that God has for you. It's the place where prophetic words are given. You may question, *"Is that word for me? Does God really want me to do that?"* Oh yes, He does! And, I can confidently say the exact words the Lord spoke to me— *Do not think you are just a little one in My kingdom. You are needed. Yes, Beloved one, you are wanted and needed!*

Since you now wear a garment of righteousness, boldly enter the Holy of Holies where His mercy seat resides, and Jesus is waiting for your arrival.
